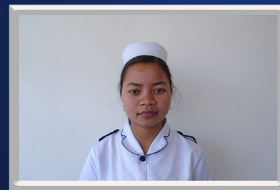

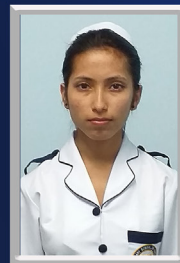

Bethany School of Nursing located at Nongrim Hills, Shillong, with an intake of 30 students per year and is run under the Management of the Dicky Ryntathiang Memorial Trust. The School is recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) and Meghalaya Nursing Council (MNC). The School has its parent hospital at Bethany Hospital, Shillong, which is one of the leading private hospitals of the city where the students will be given clinical 'hands on' training. The Students will also be provided comprehensive learning in other affiliated hospitals in Shillong and community health care in both urban and rural areas. Presently, this course caters for women only and is a compulsory residential course.

1. Mission Statement:

Bethany School of Nursing is a private Institution dedicated to educating students for the diverse opportunities offered as a career in Nursing in India and Overseas.

2. Objectives:

- To prepare students to become competent nurses and midwives in providing preventive, promotive, curative and rehabilitative services.
- To help students apply relevant knowledge from nursing and other disciplines in planning and in carrying out safe nursing care activities.
- To inculcate in students a sense of commitment and fulfillment as a citizen and as a prospective member of the profession in order to uphold the dignity of the profession.
- To teach the students the practice of compassion in the learning environment.
- To encourage students to communicate effectively with patients and members of the health team in order to promote effective interpersonal relationships and teamwork.

4. Admission requirements:

- a) Minimum age for admission will be 17 years. (as on 31st December 2021) and the maximum age limit is 35 yrs. There is no age bar for ANM/ LHV.
- b) Minimum education.
 - i. 10+2 (Arts, Commerce and Science stream) with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However Science is preferable.
 - ii. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing council.
 - iii. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/State/Centre.
 - iv. Registered ANM with pass mark.
- c) Candidates should be single (female only) of good health and good moral character

5. How to apply:

- a) Candidates should apply in the prescribed form.
- b) Application form fee is Rs. 500/- . Application form fee once paid is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- c) The application form should be completed by the applicant in her own handwriting.
- d) Full name of the candidate as spelt in the HSSLC Records should be given in the application form and in all other related forms and correspondence, except those with affidavit for change of name.
- e) The information given in the application should be correct.
- f) Copies of all the certificates enclosed should be self-attested. Once submitted, the copies of the certificates will not be returned. **DO NOT SUBMIT ANY ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES** with the application form.
- g) Completed application forms along with relevant enclosures as detailed below should reach the the School of Nursing on or before the 2nd July 2022. Application Forms not accompanied by the following enclosures will be rejected.
 - i. Duly filled application form.
 - ii. Recent passport & stamp size photographs – 2 nos. each in an envelope.
 - iii. Xerox copies of certificate:
 - a. Birth certificate
 - b. Mark Sheet Class X
 - c. Mark Sheet Class XII
 - d. Pass Certificate of Class XII
 - e. Caste certificate - ST/SC/OBC/MOBC
 - iv. Written references/recommendation from the following persons:
 - a. Principal of the school /college last attended
 - b. Character Certificate from Headman
- h) Candidates coming for Interview should bring **ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES** along with them.

6. Selection & Admission:

- a) The applicants, who fulfil the admission criteria, will be called for entrance test on 8th July 2022 at Bethany School of Nursing, Shillong at their own expense.
- b) The entrance examination will be of one and half hours duration that includes the following areas: Science, Mathematics, English and Health Education of Class X Syllabus, including Aptitude and General Knowledge.
- c) The candidates who clear the entrance examination will be called for interview.
- d) Interview:
 - The list of eligible candidates will be put up on the 15th July 2022 in the School noticeboard.
 - No information will be mailed to the Candidates for the same.
 - The applicant should ensure the specific date for interview from the particulars furnished in the prospectus. They can contact Phone No.03642522842 /7005270465. No other correspondence will be entertained.
- e) All qualified Candidates called for an interview must undergo a complete medical check – up arranged at Bethany Hospital, Shillong at their own expense. (Cost as per Hospital charges) on the 4th & 5th Aug 2022.
- f) All qualified candidates will have to appear for the personal interview on the 19th & 20th July 2022.
- g) Candidates called for an interview are asked to bring with them the originals of the certificates submitted with the application forms.
- h) Candidates are asked to make their own arrangements for accommodation in Shillong during the interview.
- i) The list of candidates selected for the course will be announced on the 2nd Aug 2022, in the school Notice Boards.
- j) The selected candidates must pay the admission fees on 9th Aug 2022, failing which, the admission granted will be cancelled within one week.

- i. Annual and monthly fees must be paid for the first three months at the specified date.
- ii. For subsequent months, monthly fees are to be paid in advance for the next three months.
- iii. Uniforms, prescribed textbooks, ID card will be provided from the school on payment.
- iv. Exposure outside the parent hospital will be charged as per actual.
- v. Examination Fees to be incurred by the student as per Meghalaya Nursing Council tariff.
- vi. Registration fee to the MNC and SNA to be paid by student as per actual.

8. Discontinuation of course

- i. A selected student who do not wish to continue the course after the payment of the fees but before the commencement of the course will not be entitled for refund of the fees already paid unless the vacant seat is filled. In such a case, the refund amount deducted shall be 20% of the total fees paid.
- ii. If a student discontinues after the commencement of the course or during the course period for any other reason, she will have to pay the fees for the remaining period of the course to the institution, and shall also forfeit all the deposits and other fees paid to the institution.

9. Accommodation:

Hostel: Hostel accommodation is provided to all students as this is a residential programme. It is mandatory that all students need to stay in the hostel accommodation provided and abide by the hostel rules and regulations.

Mess facilities: The hostel also has a mess facility that provides nutritious and fresh food every day. It is compulsory for all students to eat the food provided in the hostel. Mess fees is to be paid for the first three months at the time of admission and for the subsequent months, mess fees are to be paid in advance for the next three months. Mess fees is Rs. 3500 per month. Mess fees is subject to change depending upon variation in price level.

Laundry Facilities: Washing and ironing of school uniforms, clinical uniforms and bed sheets are taken care by the laundry department in the school so as to provide clean clothes to all students.

10. Health Care:

- a) All students are expected to be immunized for Hepatitis B Vaccine before joining the course, otherwise vaccination of the same will be given on joining the course.
- b) Annual health check-up done in the Bethany Hospital is compulsory for all.
- c) Students shall be entitled for medical facilities on subsidised rate.
- d) Dental care is available and will be a paid facility.
- e) Any cost of major illness requiring the referral of the student to a higher centre will be borne by the parent/guardian.

- 11. Leave and Vacation:**
- a) Vacations are planned according to the Indian Nursing Council Syllabus. If the students are unable to return on time due to illness, the Principal should be intimated immediately by telephone/e- mail followed by a written explanation. On return, they should submit a medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner, stating full particulars of their illness and treatment.
 - b) No other leave will be granted except for the planned vacation.
 - c) Students are not granted leave for social events in the family.
 - d) In case a student absents herself from duty/class for any reasons and the Principal is not satisfied with the explanation regarding her absence, the student will be asked to make up for the number of days she was absent at the rate of 3 days, for a day of absence, as approved by the Principal.
 - e) Those not having at least 80% of attendance for theory and 100% attendance for clinical in any subject will not be permitted to appear for examination.
- 12. Academic Progress and Clinical Evaluation:**
- All Students are expected to maintain a high academic and clinical standard of performance throughout the programme. To this effect, regular written and practical sessional examinations will be conducted.
- 13. Examination:**
- a) **Internal Assessment:** Internal assessment in each subject is carried out at prescribed time as per the weightage of the total Council marks. Passing in the Internal assessment is the pre-requisite to appearing for the Meghalaya Nursing Council examination.
 - b) **Examination:** The students will appear for theory and practical examination of the Meghalaya Nursing Council at the end of every academic year as prescribed. A monthly evaluation and a quarterly examination will be conducted every year by the School. Examination fee, as determined by the State Council, should be paid by the students.
- 14. Anti Ragging Resolution :**
- a) The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India order for implementation of Anti Ragging Recommendation of the Lyngdoh Committee – 02.04.2008 and UGC REGULATION, 2009 – 14.12.2009 is implemented strictly.
 - b) It is declared that any student, if found guilty of ragging will be terminated from the course.
- 15. Graduation:**
- a) On successful completion of the General Nursing & Midwifery programme, the graduates are awarded the GNM Certificate during the School of Nursing Convocation.
 - b) Transcript, original certificates and course completion certificates are given only when the graduates meet all the course requirements of the School.
 - c) The graduates are required to register themselves with the Meghalaya Nursing Council and also enroll as members of TNAI.
 - d) No student who has failed in the final exams, will be allowed for Graduation March.
- 16. Campus Placement**
- a) Bethany Hospital, Shillong.
 - b) Bethany Hospital Outreach, Nongpoh.
 - c) Rajagiri Hospital, Kochi, Kerela.
- 17. General Discipline:**
- a) Regular attendance as well as punctuality is expected from the students at lectures, demonstrations, practical, field works and other such academic exercises as well as experiences. They are required to attend allotted working periods in each of the prescribed subjects.
 - b) Students should wear the prescribed complete uniform for duty.
 - c) A sense of decorum and discipline is expected of every student in the school, hospital as well as in the entire campus.
 - d) Ragging is strictly prohibited. They shall not indulge either individually or collectively, in any form of activity that will bring down the good name of the Institution / Nursing profession.
 - e) Students will strive at all costs to be loyal to the Ethos of the Institution and to promote its image and status by a humane, ethical and professional code of conduct. Failure to follow these and such other regulations will necessitate the management to take disciplinary action as deemed fit.

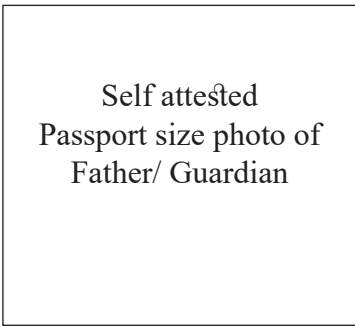
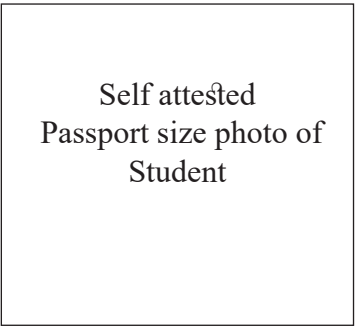

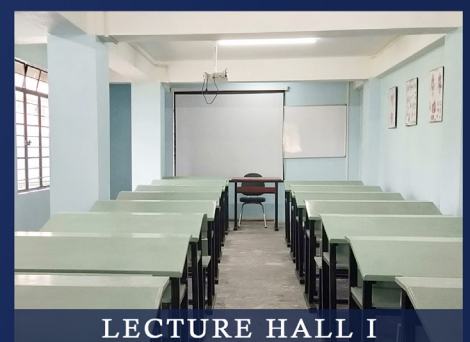
